Trans murder monitoring 2023

<u>The TGEU (Transgender Europe)</u> releases the annual update of the <u>Trans</u> <u>Murder Monitoring</u> research project. This project tracks murders of trans and gender-diverse people globally.

320 trans and gender diverse people were reported murdered between **1 October 2022 and 30 September 2023**. This total is very close to the 327 cases reported in the previous year, showing that deadly violence against trans people remains at a consistently high level. Most cases worldwide continue to go unreported. Those that are reported receive very little attention.

The Trans Murder Monitoring data does not include all reported cases worldwide, as not all trans and gender diverse murder victims are identified as trans or gender diverse in reports of their death.

Typically, a TDoR vigil includes a reading of the names of those who died from October 1 of the former year to September 30th of the current year, and may include other actions, such as candlelight vigils, dedicated church services, marches, art shows, food drives and film screenings.
